

DHS Letter Jacket Program

Students at Dexter High School are encouraged to participate in a community service program to receive a free standard letter jacket. Community service will be performed outside of the regular school day. Upon completion of the community service program and receipt of an academic/athletic/activity letter, students will be given a voucher to present to a vendor to cover the cost of a standard letter jacket (jacket with name embroidered on back). Any additional costs for added features, patches, or different jacket styles will be at the expense of the student.

Dexter High School Academic/Athletic/Activity Letter Program guidelines follow:

- Students perform 20 hours of **pre-approved** community service hours to earn a letter jacket (recording form and information available in the High School Office). Students can begin community service to earn the jacket before earning a letter. However, they cannot obtain the jacket until the letter is earned.
